9. The boy's cupcake was strawberry. The boy ate quickly.

10. This is the bike. I rode the bike.

11. I wrote down the assignment. I had already completed the assignment.

12. There is a man. A man is selling balloons.

13. I have a friend named Lane. Lane can eat five hot dogs in one meal.

14. Our sister just got accepted into Notre Dame. Her jersey is hanging on the gym wall.

15. The dog chased the ball. The dog ran down the street.
